



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
## **New District Headquarters The Dr Peter Community Centre**

The project to redevelop the 1<sup>st</sup> Romsey Group site to create a new headquarters for them, a District headquarters and a much needed community facility has received a financial boost this year, which has given some additional momentum to the project.

The Joan Stainer Trust has undertaken to match fund any sums raised towards the project, which means that any pound earned or donated immediately becomes two pounds towards the project. After a period of quiet progress this has reinvigorated the campaign and we hope to provide much more frequent articles in Woodsmoke in the future.

We are delighted to add that the Coutts Charitable Trust have

also recently donated the sum of £500 to the project, which effectively becomes One Thousand Pounds with the match funding.



The ambition to achieve at last a District Headquarters where the district can hold meetings, training sessions and similar activities moves a step closer. There has also been significant interest from several organisations within the town, who would be interested in the regular use of the facility.
